1	Heads of Agreement: Review of Commitments	
	A discussion took place focusing on paragraphs 9-11 of the Heads of Agreement	
	which described how the two organisations could work jointly and support each	
	other's objectives.	
	It was agreed that more could be done to promote each other's events on	
	social media. Speak to the respective Communications teams.	HJ/DE
	CBSC said that they were in discussion with CB about piggy-backing the	
	Christmas Party for the Player of the Year awards. If this occurred there was a	
	possibility that tours of the trophy Room for those attending could be bolted-on	
	which CF10 would organise. DE agreed to keep CF10 informed of progress.	DE
	CF10 agreed to promote CBSC organised trips, particularly Saracens but also the	
	HQ which would be established in Glasgow.	HJ
	CBSC were hoping to organise a Q&A with CB coaching staff and they suggested	
	that this could be done as a joint event. This was welcomed. DE to keep HJ	
	informed of developments and possible date.	DE
	CBSC has seen a significant increase in junior membership (now 90) this year	
	due its membership and pricing policy. However, both organisations were	
	struggling to recruit students. This was felt to be as a result of CB's prohibitive	
	pricing policy for this age group. This was a matter that had been previously	
	raised with RH but needed to be raised again at a future joint meeting. Dates	
	for this would be explored.	HJ
	CBSC had recently worked with Tom James on the promotion of Noggin beanies	

	and snapbacks. This had protected CB from its commercial agreement with Macron.	
2	Cardiff Blues Non-Executive Director posts HJ informed the meeting that CF10's mission statement had an aim of establishing a role of Supporter Director on the CBL board. However, in discussion with RH, CF10 had been made clear that such a role should not be a CF10 appointment but should be open to election amongst supporters. With the recent announcement that a new Chair plus two non-executive directors were to be appointed to a restructured CBL board, CF10 had written to RH. He informed CF10 that if anyone wished to apply for one of the roles they could do. Each application would be considered on its merits. The CF10 board would be considering the situation. CBSC didn't feel it was appropriate for them to apply for a place on the Board because it doesn't fit with their aims and objectives.
